SOLICITOR REPORT

Attorney Logsdon reported on the following: explained how other municipalities add the garbage fee into taxes, Council discussed options on how they can do garbage collecting inhouse by applying for a grant for a garbage packer, read an email from PennDot asking Borough if they can do the Multimodal grant project with \$199,000. Council told him to respond yes, he will start with Fritz to try to get the easement to do Broadhead, explained the free and clear sale coming up for 572 Rear Main, passed out a letter he received from the attorney representing 591 Main he will let them know they will need a Special Exception, Charles is working on insurance renewals and all volunteer firemen are covered under Hanover Townships insurance now even though Sugar Notch Volunteer Fire kept their charter, called Casey to see if Rachel from Reilly Engineering can be Sugar Notch's person for the ARPA grant mandatory meetings Casey said Rachel tried but couldn't get in so someone from the Borough will have to add Rachel and Casey to the ARPA share file, discussed the new ATV item added to the state code stating that Police can now seize an ATV under this new state law, asked Erin to let him know when she is ready to start up a Sugar Notch Facebook page so he can prepare Resolution and Council can set up rules and bids are going out for sewer work on May 1.

COUNCIL REPORT

Dominick reported on the following: asked Henry to get WVSA to come camera the area of the second manhole up from Woodlawn on Lower Oak because there is a constant flow of water there, exterminator is coming tomorrow between 6 and 7 a.m. they will need police department open, street light for parking lot is ready to go up, flag pole will be put up at Borough building before Memorial Day Randy is supposed to get bucket truck, 370 garbage sticker have been sold so far, monument is going to get power washed and he reminded Charles to get sewer funds into PLGIT account.

Henry reported on the following: explained to Joe (since he was absent from the last meeting) that Chris Cawley said he is going to apply for additional grant funding for streetscaping of Main, he will call Casey to see what he thinks needs to be replaced on Woodland and if we can do a grinder pump for three homes and Kendall wants storm drains on Main St. cleaned out.

Erin asked about taking down the old website, Henry said he is trying to go to a GoDaddy domain for website first. Erin asked if Verizon needed to be contacted before putting up the Hometown Hero Banners Don Bly offered to put them up at no charge. Dominick said get banners and we will get them up.
