

**INVITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Sugar Notch Borough, 892 Main Street, Sugar Notch, PA 18706 until 2:00 p.m. Prevailing Local Time (PLT) on Friday, March 6, 2024. Bids will be opened and read on or about 6:00 p.m. PLT at the March 6, 2024 council meeting.

Work shall consist of the following: Provide all labor, material and equipment necessary to furnish and install 726 LF of 8" sanitary sewer line, nine (9) sewer manholes, three (3) sanitary lateral service connections, miscellaneous piping, site work, paving, erosion control, and final site restoration.
